### ABOUT THE PROJECT

The project "Digital Upskilling of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) through Technology," led by Nasscom Foundation, aims to empower women Board of Directors (BoDs) and FPO members across Tamil Nadu by enhancing their digital, financial, and entrepreneurial skills to improve governance, operational efficiency, and business outcomes across 10 districts of Tamil Nadu.

The initiative targets training 500 women BoDs on digital and financial literacy with 250 of them receiving dedicated handholding support for technology adoption. The project also facilitates access to finance, government schemes, and digital marketplaces for FPOs, enabling 40-50 collectives to secure financial services and strengthen their operational capacity.

The program includes tailored training modules covering essential digital tools, social media marketing, e-accounting, cybersecurity, and leadership, supported by collaborations with technology partners and mentoring networks. The phased implementation plan spans one year, starting with preparatory work, infrastructure readiness, training, handholding, and concluding with assessment and impact evaluation.

### DELIVERABLES OVERVIEW

We are looking for agencies or freelancers who can conduct the baseline as well as endline studies for the project.

The project "Digital Upskilling of Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) through Technology," is designed to empower women Board of Directors (BoDs) and members of FPOs in Tamil Nadu. It focuses on enhancing their digital, financial, and entrepreneurial capabilities to strengthen governance, operational efficiency, and business outcomes. The project aims to train 500 women BoDs, while providing handholding support to 250 of them for technology adoption. Additionally, the initiative facilitates FPOs' access to finance, government schemes, and digital marketplaces.

## DESIRED PROFILE FOR THE CONSULTANT

**Applicants may be individuals or groups of individuals with a designated team of research consultants. Applicants must have at a minimum the following qualifications:**

- A Ph.D. or Master's Degree in Social Work, Sociology, Economics or a significant professional qualification in a related field.
- At least 5 years of experience conducting studies, surveys, or assessments, particularly on rural and grassroots issues demonstrating subject matter expertise in similar projects.
- Experience working in the CSR sector and conducting baseline studies.
- Understanding of the Women Entrepreneurship sector.
- Experience conducting research and studies with NGOs/INGOs.
- Strong facilitation skills and proven ability to lead participatory processes.
- Adequate and skilled network of field resources/members with relevant education and work experience, ensuring the capability of deploying resource persons for the assignment.
- Provision of samples or summaries of similar studies, detailing the budget, timeline, and client/donor information.

- Geographical presence or experience of working in the project area, with the capability of producing high-quality work under tight timeframes.
- Local knowledge and an understanding of the regional language.
- Experience in data collection methods, both quantitative and qualitative, from rural setups and facilities.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

IMT will evaluate proposals based on the following criteria:

- The experience of the consultant in undertaking similar assignments in the past.
- The proposal should detail the personnel and their credentials, demonstrating their capability to handle the assignment effectively.
- The consultant's understanding of the project objectives and requirements of the study.
- The proposed strategy for collecting data through surveys, including measures to ensure high data quality.
- Methodology and Study Plan: Including the study strategy, data collection plan, reporting framework, and research methods.
- Timeline: A detailed timeline with Gantt chart for the study, showcasing the feasibility and appropriateness of the proposed schedule.
- Financial Proposal: The financial proposal will be evaluated for its comprehensiveness and feasibility. It should provide a clear budget breakdown and demonstrate cost-effectiveness.
