- 1. Provide contextualized, structured training content aligned with the thematic areas mentioned above
- 2. Deploy Kannada-speaking trainers from the agency's existing pool who can support both inperson and virtual training in Karnataka
- 3. Ensure trainers are equipped to engage with women in rural communities

### **Training Resource Requirement (Agency)**

- 1. Proven expertise in delivering training in the specified thematic domains mentioned above.
- 2. Demonstrated experience in training nano or micro women entrepreneurs, preferably in Karnataka.
- 3. Ability and willingness to travel to rural districts across Karnataka. Project location.
- 4. Comfortable with hybrid training models (in-person + virtual).
- 5. Language proficiency in Kannada is mandatory.

## **Key Competencies**

- 1. Proven track record of delivering entrepreneurship and skilling training with women entrepreneurs
- 2. Existing training modules in the thematic areas mentioned above.
- 3. Trainer pool with experience in Karnataka who can able to localize and contextualize delivery
